

RULES FOR THE RJYC/GLOBE 2012 FISHING TOURNAMENT

1. No Minimum weight for Trolling Fish.
2. No mutilated fish will be weighed in. The decision of the weigh-master is final.
3. Lines in at 5:30a.m. Friday
4. Boats must be past the "Yacht Club Markers" in the Yacht Club basin, no later than 6:00 p.m. on Friday the 11th. All entrants must report in to the weigh station on Friday **NO EXCEPTIONS**
5. Boats must be past the "Yacht Club Markers" in the Yacht Club basin, no later than 5:00p.m. Saturday 12th.
6. Weigh station opens 5:00p.m. Friday the 11th and 4:00p.m. on Saturday the 12th
7. No boundaries.
8. Eight (8) lines total per boat of which two (2) only may be wire lines.
9. This is a Boat Tournament. Once a Tournament starts, boats cannot be substituted.
10. Fish cannot be transferred from one boat to another.
11. Ice will be available for boats at the RJYC Thursday the 10th between 4pm and 6pm and between 4pm and 6pm on Friday the 11th. Limited amounts will be available on Friday morning 4am to 6am.
12. Diesel and Gas will also be available at the Fuel Dock at posted RJYC price.
13. This Tournament also qualifies for the Annual Tony Myers Trophy for "Most Points All Tournaments".
14. IGFA Rules will apply except wire lines and electric reels for Bottom fishing are permitted.
15. Eligible Pelagic fish are Marlin, Wahoo, Tuna, Kingfish/Mackerel, Dolphin, Jack (excludes Eels, Rays and all Sharks except Mako).
16. Only groupers and snappers and big eye king fish (king fish mumma) qualify for the heaviest bottom fish prize.
17. 2 points will be granted for bottom fish and 1 point will be granted for pelagic fish
18. Barracuda will only count towards Heaviest Barracuda and not to boat most points.
19. Any protest concerning the conduct of any Angler or Boat or any allegation of a violation of any of the Tournament Rules **MUST** be filed with the Fishing Captain prior to the closing of weigh station on that particular day

Scoring:

- One point per pound of Pelagic species specified
 - Two points per pound of Bottom Fish species specified
